YUKON TRAIL TRIP 20-25 August 2019

Northern Canada. 150-200km trail running in timed stages over mix of distances & vertical. Lodge/Yurt based. Open to hikers (modified program).



Location – Southwest Yukon

We will be based at Mount Logan Lodge in Haines Junction, a village on the edge of a vast and spectacular wilderness, gateway to the Kluane National Park and Reserve. This protected region is home to Canada's tallest mountains. Glaciers feed rivers that flows through the sprawling Alsek Valley. We finish the trip near Whitehorse at Muktuk ranch and home of sled dogs. Options for activities such as canoeing, natural hot springs, animal reserve.

Wildlife: Dall Sheep, mountain goats, caribou, wolves, grizzlies, black bears roam in the region.

Weather: Yukon weather can be cooler than in Europe or lower parallels in Canada for same time of year. Average August temperatures range from 5-18 degrees Celsius. A kit list will be provided. This time of year there is a chance to see the Northern Lights!

- Meet participants at Whitehorse airport
- Transfer to Mount Logan Lodge, Haines Junction
- Group Briefing and Welcome Dinner

Wednesday 21 August

- Breakfast at lodge. Packed Lunch.
- Stage1: Alsek Valley, 50km / 250m+ (25km option)
- Evening Briefing and dinner at lodge.

Thursday 22 August

- Breakfast at lodge
- A.M. Stage 2: Kings Throne. 16km / 1250m+ (vertical). Picnic lunch, Kathleen Lake.
- P.M. Stage 3: Auriol Trail 15 km/400m+ (loop)
- Evening Briefing and dinner at lodge.

Friday 23 August

- Early breakfast at lodge. Packed lunch.
- Stage 4: Samuels Trail. 40km/200m+ run to Glacier or CottonWood Trail (65km/550m+)
- Evening Briefing and dinner at lodge.

Saturday 24 August

- Stage 5: Sheep creek / Buillon Plateau Trail. 25km/885m+.
- Return to lodge. Prepare Checkout.
- Closing 'party' (meal & awards) at Mount Logan Lodge
- Transfer towards Whitehorse, Check in at Muktuk Adventures
- Options (depend on time) Takhini Hot Springs thermal mineral waters, visit with dogs, and/or canoe

Sunday 25 August

- Breakfast at Muktuk Adventures. Checkout.
- Optional activities as above and Yukon Wildlife Preserve.
- Transfer to Whitehorse airport.

Note – program is subject to change at the discretion of the organisers and trail options may be adapted such as but not limited to Parks Canada restrictions and / or weather.
